

#2 AMERICAN COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY COUNCIL

<p>Composition & Tenure</p>	<p>The Society's representative and alternate to the Council of the American College of Radiology shall be appointed by the President to a 3-year term in accordance with the procedures of Article XII of the Constitution.</p> <p>The Executive Committee has the power to allow the Councilor to serve more than two consecutive three-year terms, if the ACR Councilor is willing to continue in this role.</p> <p>The councilor shall serve as a non-voting member of the Executive Committee. In his/her absence the alternate councilor should attend the Executive Committee meeting.</p>
<p>Responsibility</p>	<p>Represent the interests of ASNR membership at the ACR. Develop a structured and directed agenda so that ASNR can be an influential caucus in ACR.</p>
<p>Goals (2011-2012)</p>	<p>Primary Goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ To foster cooperation between the ACR and ASNR in their responses to the changing health care environment ◆ To maintain the central role of Radiology in neuroimaging, and to advocate for neuroradiology in interactions with the AMA, insurers, and state and federal entities. ◆ To advocate for appropriate coverage and reimbursement for neuroradiology studies, including newly developed procedures, as supported by sound evidence. ◆ To have the general radiology community recognize the importance of subspecialization to the practice of radiology, specifically the added benefit of fellowship trained neuroradiologists as the experts in the field. ◆ To foster partnership with ACR on education, research, and quality initiatives. <p>Continuing Goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ To represent the interests of the ASNR at the ACR. ◆ To inform and educate the ASNR on issues confronting the ACR. ◆ To make the ACR leadership cognizant of the issues and problems facing the ASNR. ◆ To develop common ground between the ASNR and the ACR. ◆ Work with ACR leadership, and the Chair of the ACR Commission on Neuroradiology to maintain an active Neuroradiology Commission within the ACR. ◆ Review all proposed ACR policies, assess the potential impact on ASNR members, and formulate an action plan in order to influence actions taken at the Annual Meeting of the ACR. ◆ Negotiate and develop education links for ACR members.
