

#3 AUDIT COMMITTEE

Composition & Tenure	4 voting members: President and 3 Senior members, one of whom shall be appointed annually by the President to serve a 3-year term. The appointed member with the longest tenure shall serve as Chair.
Responsibility	Shall annually review the accounts of the Treasurer and retain a certified public accountant for the purpose of auditing and certifying the annual report of the Treasurer. The ranking member of the Audit Committee who is not a candidate for elective office or position shall supervise and certify the annual election, subject to the provisions of Article VIII of the Constitution.
Accountability	... to the Executive Committee through the Treasurer

President - serves 1-year term	Senior Member #1 - acts as Chair, serving 3rd year of 3	Senior Member #2 - serving 2nd year of 3, moving to Chair next year	Senior Member #3 - appointed by President annually to serve 3-year term, eventually becoming Chair
