<p>Goals and Responsibilities (2011-2012)</p>	<p>Primary Goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Work with Education Committee to incorporate core curriculum with electronic material that is linked to eCME educational content.. ◆ Collaborate with key volunteers (Program Chair and specialty society co-chairs for Annual Meeting. ASNR staff to develop and maintain Self-Assessment Module Sessions (SAMs). <p>Continuing Goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ The Electronic Education & eCME Subcommittee of Education will oversee the ongoing evaluation of ASNR website appearance and content, as well as have responsibility for electronic education (including <i>NERUOGraphics</i>), Public Relations, on-line ASNR communications, webmaster and other on-line activities. ◆ The Chair of the Electronic Education eCME Subcommittee will provide overall guidance and supervision, and will report to the Executive Committee via the President. The Chair will also arrange for and chair meetings of the committee at the ASNR Annual Meeting, and at interim meetings, collect agenda items, and assign times at these meetings. The Chair will also report to the Executive Committee of staffing needs, priorities, and budgeting with the assistance of the Director of Communications and the CEO. ◆ The Chair reviews web content and supervises web activities with the Director of Communications, coordinates with the ASNR committee chairs for content and reports, and solicits preparation of pertinent new items for on-line display. ◆ Selecting and editing online webcasts and <i>NeuroGraphics</i> presentations on the ASNR website under the sponsorship of the Neuroradiology Education and Research Foundation. These presentations will provide Continuing Medical Education (CME) for ASNR members and Neuroradiology fellows. The webcasts will include presentations from the ASNR Annual Meeting and also invited submissions from Guest Editors and contributors. <i>NeuroGraphics</i> presentations will be selected from Annual Meeting Scientific Exhibits. ◆ Interface with the Educational Technology Subcommittee of Education, Education Committee, President-Elect and Scientific Exhibits Committee representative regarding the curriculum for on-line webcasts and <i>NEUROGraphics</i>. This cooperative effort will address the educational needs of members, fellows and fellowship training programs. ◆ Assist staff and volunteer and CME consultant efforts with ongoing CME processes and procedures for the online webcasts. ◆ Provide ongoing evaluation to determine optimum, appropriate technology for web presentations. ◆ Additional projects as determined by needs as they arise. ◆ Provide ongoing re-evaluation of an organizational structure to efficiently accomplish the above-mentioned goals. ◆ Work with Education Committee and ASNR staff to coordinate Maintenance of Certification (MOC) materials. ◆ Add value to ASNR membership through initiatives in education, research, clinical practice, and Maintenance of Certification (MOC). ◆ Enhance ASNR Web/CME content to ensure a “one-stop-shop” site for all components of Maintenance of Certification (MOC).
