

## # 20 GOLD MEDAL AWARD COMMITTEE

<b>Composition</b>	... consists of 3 Senior members rotating to the position of Chair, plus the 1st Past-President and the President, as well as 2 Senior members (appointed yearly by the President) who have received the Gold Medal of the Society.
<b>Responsibility</b>	To recommend to the Executive Committee, on a yearly basis, the highest award of the ASNR - the <b>Gold Medal</b> . This award will be presented to that person who has made outstanding contributions to the field of neuroradiology, and who has furthered, in an exceptional way, the mission of the ASNR. The award is presented at the Annual Meeting.
<b>Goals (2011-2012)</b>	To implement the selection of the <b>Gold Medal Award</b> recipient, who will receive the award at the next Annual Meeting.
<b>Accountability</b>	... to the Executive Committee through the President. All committee members and the 5 immediate Past-Presidents of the Society should be polled for possible nominees, before finalizing the slate for committee consideration. The Central Office shall organize, with the guidance of the Chair, a conference call to review nominated individuals, prior to presenting recommendations to the Executive Committee.
