

#13 PUBLICATION COMMITTEE

Composition & Tenure	The Publication Committee shall consist of voting and non-voting members. Voting members shall include the Treasurer, the chair of the Publication Committee of the ASHNR, a <i>Member-in-Training</i> , a <i>Research Scientist Member</i> (whenever possible), and additional members appointed by the President, one as chair, each to serve three-year terms. Each appointment may be renewed by the President, with the approval of the Executive Committee. Non-voting members of the Committee shall be the Editor and Deputy Editors of the <i>AJNR</i> .
Responsibility	The Publication Committee, with the approval of the Executive Committee, shall be responsible for publishing the official journal and other Society publications. It shall plan and propose for consideration by the Education and the Executive Committees specific projects to further the educational mission of the Society. It shall help to implement those projects given final approval and funding by the Executive Committee. The Publication Committee shall also recommend to the Executive Committee a publishing company to publish the official journal.
Committee Meetings	The Committee generally meets: (a) during the RSNA in Chicago in November; (b) during the ASNR meeting in the Spring.
Goals (2011-2012)	<p>Primary Goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ With the Editor, consider whether the <i>AJNR</i> should expand its number of pages to meet increasing submissions. ◆ Expand advertising revenue. ◆ Provide adequate financing of entire editorial staff. ◆ Provide ideas for expanding impact factor of journal and wider circulation in institutional libraries. <p>Continuing Goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ To oversee and ensure financial stability of the <i>AJNR</i>. ◆ Explore new publications to support the mission of ASNR. ◆ Explore new electronic opportunities for the <i>AJNR</i>, and develop ways to monitor their effectiveness. ◆ Assess the impact of charging fees for access to <i>AJNR</i> online, and make recommendations regarding the consequences and time line for such a transition. ◆ Assess the efficiency of web-based review of manuscripts with the goal of decreasing turn-around of manuscripts, and report findings to the Executive Committee during RSNA.
