

#15 RESEARCH SCIENTIST COMMITTEE

Composition & Tenure	Shall be comprised of <i>Research Scientist</i> members. The chair of the committee shall be appointed by the President, shall serve a 2-year term, and shall sit as a voting member of the Executive Committee.
Responsibility	Shall foster the enrollment and participation of PhDs, and other trained Neuroscientists to the Society. The committee will make recommendations to the Executive Committee on how to improve the scientific content of the Society and its offerings.
Goals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Promote the interests of Research Scientists within the ASNR. ◆ Develop an educational advanced imaging session for the Annual Meeting; and promote it by publishing information on the session. ◆ In cooperation with the Program Committee, develop for the Annual Meeting one or more sessions consisting of original research and targeted at research scientists ◆ Maintain the joint workshop with the ISMRM for the Annual Meeting. ◆ Select a non-member scientist who would be honored by presenting a talk at the Annual Meeting, and recognized with an award certificate/plaque. ◆ Invite Research Scientists who speak (have spoken) at the Annual Meeting to become members.
