

Audit Committee

<i>Composition & Tenure</i>	4 voting members: President and 3 Senior members, one of whom shall be appointed annually by the President to serve a 3-year term. The appointed member with the longest tenure shall serve as Chair.
<i>Responsibility</i>	Shall annually review the accounts of the Treasurer and retain a certified public accountant for the purpose of auditing and certifying the annual report of the Treasurer. The ranking member of the Audit Committee who is not a candidate for elective office or position shall supervise and certify the annual election, subject to the provisions of Article VIII of the Constitution.
<i>Accountability</i>	... to the Executive Committee through the Treasurer
