Continuing Medical Education (CME)/Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

Composition & Tenure	Shall consist of: the President, the President-Elect, the immediate Past-President, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the chair of the Publication Committee and other ASNR members. When possible, the committee shall include a <i>Research Scientist</i> and <i>Member-in-Training</i> . The Chair shall serve for 3 years.						
Responsibility	Be responsible for the continuing medical education of ASNR members and other professionals that participate in the diverse educational activities of the Society. At the Direction of the Executive Committee, plan and propose for consideration by the Executive Committee projects to further the educational mission of the Society, help to implement those educational projects given final approval and funding by the Executive Committee; and have liaison with the Program, Publication and Clinical Practice Committees. The Education Committee will be the parent oversight body for subcommittees focused on eCME and technology systems. The Education Committee and the Program Committee will work in concert with the presidential appointee and liaison to the ACCME.
