<b><i>Goals</i></b>	<p><b><i>Continuing Goals:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ To encourage and promote the application of sound clinical research methods in neuroradiology by offering educational sessions and hands-on assistance to prospective investigators.</li> <li>◆ To inform members on the rationale and methodology of performing clinical outcomes research in the field of neuroradiology.</li> <li>◆ To provide a source for coordination of multi-institutional and multi-disciplinary clinical outcomes research projects.</li> <li>◆ To build a central data base of clinical outcomes research investigations which can serve as a resource for the entire field of neuroradiology in the generation of evidence based practice standards and appropriateness guidelines.</li> <li>◆ Report annually to the Executive Committee regarding status of special projects being funded by the Foundation.</li> <li>◆ Act as an interface among ASNR Executive Committee, ARR Neuroradiology Commission, and ACRIN, encouraging neuroradiology-related projects.</li> <li>◆ Inform Executive Committee of neuroradiology-related projects currently planned by ACRIN.</li> </ul>
