<p><i>Composition & Tenure</i></p>	<p>Shall be comprised of the fellows in Neuroradiology programs who are current ASNR <i>Members-in-Training</i>, as well as former fellows who graduated in the prior 5 years, and are active members of the ASNR. The Chair of the Fellowship Directors Committee and the ASNR Vice-President serve as liaisons on the committee, to ensure appropriate communication with the Executive Committee. The Chair of the committee shall be appointed by the President, shall serve a 2-year term, and shall participate as a non-voting member of the Executive Committee.</p>
<p><i>Recommendations for Committee Membership</i></p>	<p>Program Directors will be asked to submit their recommendations for appointment to the committee to the <i>Program Director Coordinator</i> at the Headquarters Office. Recommendations will then be forwarded to the President-Elect and Vice-President for appointments. The President-Elect shall attempt to achieve representation of the main geographic regions in the North America, when making the appointments.</p>
<p><i>Goals and Responsibilities</i></p>	<p>The committee shall be responsible for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify the interests of young professionals in the Society at the Annual Meeting. • Improve communication between the Society’s leadership and young professionals. • Plan focused educational sessions on advanced imaging for current fellows and recently-graduated fellows. • Improve dissemination of information to young professionals in the Society. Facilitate social networking opportunities for young professionals. • Provide support for residents and medical students interested in Neuroradiology.
<p><i>Advancement</i></p>	<p>Members exiting the committee are expected to inform the Chair of the Fellowship Directors Committee, and the Vice-President of the committees they would be interested in serving on as a member.</p>
